

Installing the Visibone Web-safe Palette

To install the Visibone palette in Photoshop CS3:

1. Check to see if the Visibone palettes (VisiBone.aco and VisiBone2.aco) are already present in the Photoshop directory under /Presets/Color Swatches. If not, download the palettes to that directory, from the Visibone web site, www.visibone.com.
2. From within Photoshop, click Window > Swatches.
3. Click on the “down” arrow to get the menu for the Swatches window.
4. Choose Visibone or Visibone2. If the colors appear jumbled when they appear in the Swatches panel, simply resize the panel until the colors are ordered properly.

To install the Visibone Palette in Fireworks CS3:

1. Download the VisiBone palette from the VisiBone web site, <http://www.visibone.com/swatches/>. For CS3, select the one isolated in a separate paragraph at the very bottom, vsiBone2_Fireworks.rf.act. Save the palette somewhere in the Fireworks directory. (If there is a specific area where Fireworks CS3 stores swatches, I sure can't find it. I use the Plug-Ins directory.)
2. Click Window > Swatches to display the Swatches menu, if it isn't displayed already.
3. Click the “down” arrow to get the menu for the Swatches window. Click Replace Swatches, browse to where you saved the palette, and select it.

Note that if you choose a different palette at some time in the future, you will have to repeat Steps #2 and 3 above to restore the VisiBone palette. In contrast to prior versions of Fireworks, an external palette such as this doesn't seem to be added to the Swatches menu.
